I. Key Market Highlight

- During Monday's session, 169 transactions with an aggregate volume of 284633 shares and a value of SYP 6.58Mln was recorded on the DSE trading platform.
- Overall, during the session, 12 out of the 27 listed stocks recorded market activities, amongst which 3 listed securities witnessed positive share price movements while 4 listed securities recorded negative share price movements.
- As for the index, DWX declined by -283.16 points (-0.21%) compared to the last session to close at 135560.87 points.




DWX Index Month-over-Month
